Canteen Service - General Information

The meals and snacks service will resume as from Monday 7 September 2020.

Necessary adjustments have been implemented, particularly with regard to the service areas. For example, secondary school pupils will be seated at the table by "Bulle" according to the levels, sections and classes in accordance with the standards laid down in Circular
76.86 of the Wallonia-Brussels Federation. The teachers' canteen will be used for secondary school pupils, while the cafeteria area will be temporarily closed. Based on the number of registrations, other adjustments in order to comply to the space and timetable criteria could be implemented in the following weeks.

Table service will be provided directly by the staff. All self-service will be suspended, including the salad bar.

The safety and precautionary measures below follow the recommendations of the Belgian authorities and have been officially approved. We are committed to ensuring social distancing for the secondary school, the respect of a correct flow in and out of the canteen and the teachers' room and the use of masks before and after the meal. The school and the APEEE make every effort to ensure that cleaning is impeccable and that pupils disinfect their hands regularly.

Hygiene Measures:

- All staff, chefs and service employees, are required to use the mask during their shift (from the start of production to the end of the shift), to disinfect their hands and surfaces regularly).
- Sanitation of the canteen and the cleaning of all surfaces is carried out with specific products, and after each table service. The kitchens are cleaned and disinfected at the end of each daily production.
- Gel sanitisers are available at the entrance to each refectory and at several entry points to the canteen.

Table seating planning:

- The children in the nursery cycle-P1-P2 classes will be seated at the table by the respective teachers.
- Children in P3-P4-P5 will seat at the table per class, under the supervision of the teacher or monitor. Unnecessary travel is to be avoided to minimise contact between pupils/staff/supervisors.

Further information:

- All classes in the nursery cycle and classes in the primary cycle can go to the canteen
 without masks, unless their parents opt for mask use. Ideally, masks are to be placed
 in clothes' pockets and not on the table.
- Teachers or supervisors will ensure that pupils disinfect their hands just before arriving at the canteen.
- All these hygiene measures are also applied to the snacks of the Garderies.
- Some menu options (soup, salad bar, Green Meal) will be temporarily suspended.
- Pupils bringing their own meals are no longer authorised to access the canteen area. The use of the microwave ovens is temporarily suspended.
- As a result of exceptional circumstances, any necessary changes to the timetable and terms of service will be communicated as soon as possible.
