Canteen Service - General Information

The meals and snacks service will resume as from Monday 7 September 2020.

Necessary adjustments have been implemented, particularly with regard to the service areas. Secondary school pupils will be seated at the table by "Bulle" according to the levels, sections and classes in accordance with the standards laid down in <u>circular 76.86 of the Wallonia-Brussels Federation</u>. The teachers' canteen will be used for secondary school pupils, while the cafeteria area will be temporarily closed. Based on the number of registrations, other adjustments in order to comply to the space and timetable criteria could be implemented in the following weeks. Secondary school pupils will be seated at the table by "Bulle" according to the levels, sections and classes in accordance with the standards laid down in circular 76.86 of the Wallonia-Brussels Federation.

Table service will be provided directly by the staff. All self-service will be suspended, including the salad bar.

The safety and precautionary measures below follow the recommendations of the Belgian authorities and have been officially approved. We are committed to ensuring social distancing for the secondary school, the respect of a correct flow in and out of the canteen and the teachers' canteen and the use of masks before and after the meal. The school and the APEEE make every effort to ensure that cleaning is impeccable and that pupils disinfect their hands regularly.

Hygiene Measures:

- All staff, chefs and service employees, are required to use the mask during their shift (from the start of production to the end of the shift), to disinfect their hands and surfaces regularly).
- Sanitation of the canteen and the cleaning of all surfaces is carried out with specific products, and after each table service. The kitchens are cleaned and disinfected at the end of each daily production.
- Gel sanitisers are available at the entrance to each refectory and at several entry points to the canteen.

Table seating arrangement:

- S1 students will seat at the table without separation
- Students from S2 to S7 will be placed at the table by class level and language section. They should always occupy as far as possible the same place. Unnecessary movements are to be avoided for the same reasons as for the other classes.

Further information:

- Students from S1 to S7 are required to go to the canteen with a mask, to be kept until they reach the assigned place. Once at the table, they can take it off, but they must put it back on when leaving the room. Ideally, masks are to be placed in clothes' pockets and not on the table.
 - When entering the dining room they must disinfect their hands with the gel provided.
- All these hygiene measures are also applied to the snacks of the Garderies.
- In order to allow easy circulation, different exits from the refectory are provided for students and teachers.
- Some menu options (soup, salad bar, Green Meal) will be temporarily suspended.
- Pupils bringing their own meals are no longer authorised to access the canteen area.
 The use of the microwave ovens is temporarily suspended.
- No occasional tickets will be allowed
- Badge recharging will be possible only online (<u>My APEEE</u>)
- As a result of exceptional circumstances, any necessary changes to the timetable and terms of service will be communicated as soon as possible.
