On March 21st, 2025, the Office of the Secretary General (OSG) organised the annual In-Service Training of Management Staff of the European Schools Network. Topics presented during these two days included, among others, a session on “Artificial Intelligence” given by Kari Kivinen, former Secretary General of the European Schools (2012 – 2016), since 2020 Education Outreach Expert at the European Union Intellectual Property Office (EUIPO) Observatory.
