

About TEDx, x = independently organized event

In the spirit of ideas worth spreading, TEDx is a program of local, self-organized events that bring people together to share a TED-like experience. At a TEDx event, TED Talks video and live speakers combine to spark deep discussion and connection. These local, self-organized events are branded TEDx, where x = independently organized TED event. The TED Conference provides general guidance for the TEDx program, but individual TEDx events are self-organized. (Subject to certain rules and regulations.)

At our TEDxYouth@EEB3 event, TED video and live speakers will combine to spark deep discussion and connection in a small group. The TED Conference provides general guidance for the TEDx program, but individual TEDx events, including ours, are self-organised. All TEDxYouth events are organised by young people.

On the 12th of June 2017, we organised the <u>EEB3 Conference 2017</u>, with four talks spread over three periods. We hosted over 150 attendees and had extremely positive feedback, which led us to start organising the TEDxYouth@EEB3 event. We also created a 14-page post-conference report, which you may read <u>here</u>.

<u>TEDxYouth@EEB3</u> 2018 is organised by 20 hard-working and motivated students from S3 to S7 from every section, and three teachers. It will take place on the 7th of February 2018. Attendance is limited to 70 teachers and students. However, parents, teachers (and anybody else) can watch the event live via our website.
